

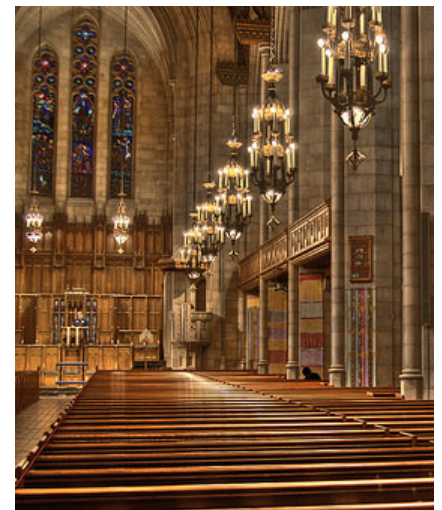

1. Catholic Chapel at the Colorado Christian Home for Children and Families- Tennyson Center in Denver, Colorado.



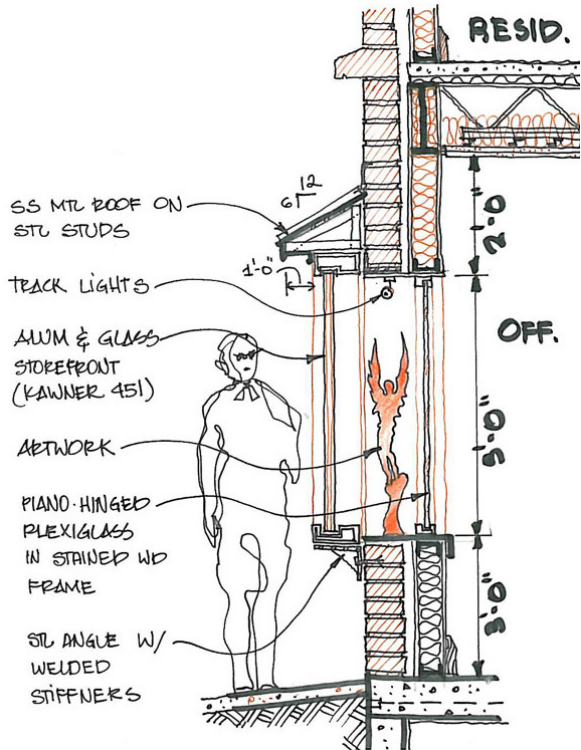
2. Fourth Presbyterian Church of Chicago: Expansion master planning of refurbishment and addition for the old Chicago landmark
